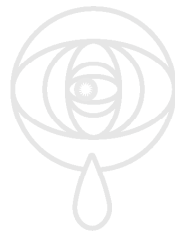

- 1 Bin Number** Ours look a little atypical, but this is how we find the wine in the cellar.
- 2 Grape Variety** Pinot Noir, Cabernet Sauvignon, Chardonnay, Sauvignon Blanc, etc.
- 3 Producer** The farmer, winemaker, or entity that made or bottled the wine.
- 4 Appellation** At a minimum, a legal boundary for where the grapes come from, though it can also define style and production methods. Napa Valley is an example of the former, and Champagne is an example of the latter.
- 5 Vineyard/Cuvée Name** A bit of a mix here. This goes beyond the legal appellation. It could be a cute name for a wine or something more technical like a vineyard or sub-appellation.
- 6 Location** Larger definition of the wine's source.
- 7 Vintage** The year the grapes were harvested.



**What is Skin Contact or Orange wine?** Typically white wine is pressed and the juice is immediately removed from the skins of the grapes, delivering a clear, brightly colored wine. So what happens if you leave the skins in contact with the juice? You'll start to take on more color, texture, and flavor from the grape skins. Honestly, this is probably the original way that white wine was made.

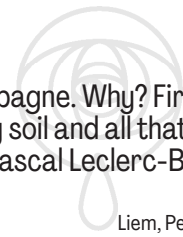

Champagne can get a bit complicated. The appellation is at the northern limit of wine production, which means that the weather is cold and erratic, and inconsistent weather leads to inconsistent wine, so producers started blending wines from different grape varieties, vintages, and vineyards to create wines in their own consistent style.

There are a lot of styles of Champagne, but here's how the big houses (i.e. Veuve Clicquot) make Champagne. First, they'll harvest or purchase grapes from all over Champagne. Next, they'll ferment all of those grapes (often separated by vineyard parcel and variety) and store them in various vessels to build a large library of still wines, "vins clairs." These are usually tart and have an alcohol content of 10.5-11% abv. From this library of vins clairs, the chef de cave starts blending. The **base** of the blend will be an assortment of vins clairs from the most recent harvest, but the chef de cave will also pick wines from their library to create a flavor profile in line with their previous releases and bottle it, but where are the bubbles?

To develop Champagne's classic mousse, they'll add a mixture of wine, sugar and yeast, *liqueur de tirage*, to every bottle. This combo will ferment in the bottle, slowly adding carbonation and that classic brioche aromatic to the wine.

Now there's one step left, **disgorgement**. Once deemed ready, the winemaker will pop the top off the bottle to remove the yeast and add a little wine (often mixed with sugar to balance high acidity), **dosage**. Now it's ready to be shipped to Tennessee!



**Thibaud Boudignon** has quickly established himself in the upper echelon of the Loire Valley's producers. He started making wine under his own name with a small selection of vineyards in 2009 and is now revered as one of the Loire's very best. Boudignon is incredibly focused on the health of his vines and the quality of sites his vines grow upon. He farms with biodynamic practices.

**Anjou Blanc** - A fantastic Chenin Blanc and a great introduction to Boudignon's style of winemaking. Lean, mineral, and austere.

**Clos de Fremine** - A close neighbor to Clos de la Hutte and planted in 2015. A mixture of sand and schist soils.

**Clos de la Hutte** - Planted on very thin soils (~6 inches) on top of schist. This is Boudignon's most prized vineyard and it's easy to understand why. This vineyard was only planted in 2011 and will only get better with time.

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**François Chidaine** has been one of the world's greatest producers of Chenin Blanc and a pioneer of Biodynamic farming for decades. Starting with just 3 hectares of vines, his estate has now grown over tenfold. Chidaine started his estate in Montlouis-sur-Loire, across the Loire River from the much more famous home of Chenin, Vouvray. Today, Chidaine has vineyards on both sides of the river, including Vouvray's famed Clos Baudoin. Not so fun fact: Chidaine isn't allowed to label his wines of Vouvray as such due to an old rule restricting the label to wines made within the appellation's boundaries, even though his winery is so close. Here's a rundown of the wines we carry:

**Les Tuffeaux** - Named for the soft Tuffeau limestone of Touraine. This is classic off-dry version of Montlouis from multiple parcels with vines ranging in age from 30 to 90 years old. Residual Sugar: 14.8 g/L

**Les Grillonnières** - From a south facing slope of 100 year old vines made by François' daughter, Alice. A powerful Chenin, inspiring plenty of confidence in the next generation.

**Les Bournais** - Les Bournais sits on a limestone plateau, reminiscent of Vouvray's best terroir. Convinced that it was one of the very best sites in Montlouis, Chidaine planted this vineyard in 1999. This is probably his closest wine to Vouvray outside in Montlouis delivering plenty of chalk and weight. "Les Bournais" is the name of the particular limestone of this vineyard.

**Les Bournais Franc de Pied** - Back in the mid 1800s a little root louse known as Phylloxera hitched a ride from the Americas and proceeded to decimate vineyards throughout the rest of the world. The best solution was to graft *Vitis Vinifera* (the species of vine responsible for the world's most popular wines) on to American rootstock that is resistant to the pest. Now, virtually all wine you drink is planted on American roots. This is an incredibly rare treat and a risky endeavor. Chenin Blanc planted on its own roots in one of Chidaine's most prized vineyards. Truly a rare treat.

**Les Epinays** - Available only in Magnum, this is the same wine as Les Bournais, but 60% of the wine is made in wine globe, a glass vessel lending a more precise view of terroir, though precision doesn't always lead to inspiration, so the remaining 40% is aged in neutral barrel.

**Baudoin** - One of Vouvray's great terroirs. Broad in texture. Classic Vouvray sec through and through.

**Les Choisses** - Named for the flinty soils of the three parcels it's sourced from in Montlouis. Vines vary in age from 30-90 years old.

**Les Argiles** - From plots surrounding Clos Baudoin, Argiles (clays) is grown on deeper clay soils in Vouvray.

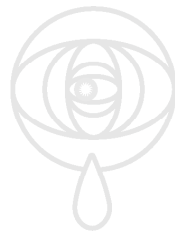

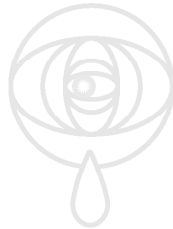


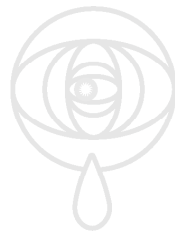
